You are entitled to customs duty exemption upon moving to the Republic of Croatia, and you can import goods within 12 months from the date of move (at once or on several occasions).

How is customs duty calculated in Croatia? In Croatia, the customs duty rate is calculated on the basis of the Common Customs Tariff of the EU and is charged to the importer.

That tourists usually imported into the customs territory of Croatia are governed by provisions which allow unimpeded import of such goods, usually only the duties of his oral declaration to the customs ...

Croatia is a member of the European Union, meaning that Union citizens can travel to Croatia with no customs or tax restrictions when entering and exiting the country.

Once registered, importers and exporters must gather and submit various documentation to initiate customs clearance. This documentation may include invoices, packing lists, and transport ...

Spot checks can occur even if you pass through the "nothing to declare" portal, but this happens infrequently. However, if you are caught with prohibited goods, the penalties are severe.

Submission of Customs Declaration: The importer or their representative must submit a completed customs declaration form to the Croatian customs authorities. This form contains detailed information ...
