Yes, you can use polystyrene boxes to grow food. Many people confuse polystyrene with PVC, polyvinyl chloride, which can release the toxic substances dioxin, lead, and phthalates.

Foam box vegetables are not toxic, but the foam material is exposed to the sun for a long time, plus some nutrients in the soil, vegetables and fertilizers. The long time use is likely to cause ...
