According to Slovenian legislation, it is necessary to obtain a building permit for larger solar power plants - i.e. power plants with a capacity of more than 1 MW.

As a result, Slovenia announced a steady pipeline of new solar projects in recent months, ranging from a 9.9 MW solar power plant in Prapretno to a 3MW solar power plant at the Port of Koper.
