It took twenty-four years for Christo and Jeanne Claude to realise their ambition to wrap the Reichstag in Berlin. It started in 1971 with a suggestion from American journalist Michael Cullen who was based in ...

The idea proved controversial even after the fall of the Berlin Wall in 1989, but in 1994, Christo and Jeanne-Claude finally received permission for this most ambitious project.

Thirty years ago, Germany's parliament building "disappeared" under silver fabric for two weeks. The work of art by Christo and Jeanne-Claude is now ...

Berlin is celebrating thirty years since Christo and Jeanne-Claude transformed the Reichstag, a historic legislative government building, into a monumental work of art.
