There is no solar tax credit in 2026. However, if you installed solar panels before December 31, 2025, you may be in line for a tax break when you file your 2025 tax return.

Form 5695 is the official IRS tax form you must use to claim the federal solar tax credit when you file your taxes. You can download a copy of Form 5695 (PDF) on the IRS website. The ...

The federal solar tax credit is overlooked by many taxpayers. Read about how to offset the cost of installation & how to claim this tax credit.

The solar tax credit is a powerful 30 % incentive, but it only offsets taxes you actually owe. Unused amounts roll forward until they're gone, so plan for multi-year use if your tax bill is low.

The credit is nonrefundable, so the credit amount you receive can't exceed the amount you owe in tax. You can carry forward any excess unused credit, though, and apply it to reduce the tax you owe in ...

You claim the solar tax credit by filing IRS Form 5695 with your federal tax return, allowing you to deduct 30% of your solar installation costs directly from your tax bill.

This is a nonrefundable tax credit, which means you will not get a tax refund for the amount of the tax credit that exceeds your tax liability.¹⁵ However, you can carry over any unused amount of tax credit ...
